1. IMS Ahmedabad Chapter

1.1 Annual General Body Meeting (AGBM) on July 16, 2019

The annual general body meeting of Indian Meteorological Society Ahmedabad (IMSA) Chapter was held on July 16, 2019 at SAC Bopal campus Ahmedabad. Around 50 members participated in this meeting. The meeting started with welcome remarks by Chairman IMSA followed by approval of minutes of the last AGBM. 3.2 A brief summary about the Brainstorming Meet on Chennai Water Management (BSMCWM) held on 3.8.2019 jointly by IMS Chennai Chapter and Regional Meteorological Centre, Chennai

Keeping in view the water scarcity and precarious digging of bore-wells to the depth of even 400-1000 feet below the ground level at some locations in the coastal city of Chennai, BSMCWM was conducted on 3rd August 2019 by inviting subject experts to

discuss, deliberate and suggest ways and means to avert water crisis in future. IMS National Council partially supported this event.

In total, 61 persons (14 resource persons; 16 from IMS & RMC Chennai; 15 Research Scholars, Consultants & PG Students; 12 from Print, Audio & visual media channels besides 4 volunteers) attended the Meet. Based on 14 invited lectures, recommendations were drafted in the summary and wrap-up session at the end of the day.

The recommendations were submitted to appropriate Government authorities (from the Hon'ble Chief Minister of Tamil Nadu to the Hon'ble Ministers and Officials concerned) on 10th August 2019 for consideration of action as deemed The Newsletter of Chennai Chapter 'Breeze' was prepared as a combined volume for December 2018 & June 2019 (Vol. 18, Issue 2 & Vol 19, Issue 1) and it includes the Special Issue on BSMCWM. In this issue of Breeze, 5 articles have been written by resource persons on the topics of lectures delivered by them in the BSMCWM.
